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WHAT IS YOUR WILL?

What is the deepest desire of the independent spirit? It is to be the Master of the earth, to govern the course of events, to make his influence felt everywhere. Nothing escapes his attention, nothing is too humble or insignificant to convey a meaning to him. His mind penetrates everything, he moves and is being moved, and his will manifests itself in all that happens. Such is the desire, but where is the practice?

Interstellar Communication stands for this trend, this age old dream of mankind, which was inherent in every great thought and deed - and we shall bring it into practice. Through the power of knowledge, we are building up a field of force, that extends itself increasingly into the thought currents of earthlings. The whole scene is to be altered. Unsightly in the beginning and remarked by only few, the movement will spread and grow irresistible, for it is the New Enterprise.

Which are the questions that arise in your mind as soon as you hear of such things? Beyond doubt, the mere mention of our field of force will not only arouse your interest, but it will touch your emotions in a new and unprecedented way. After conceiving this reality you will never be the same as before, for in conceiving it, your own individual field of force will be affected.

What then, is the nature of this field? That can be laid down in simple, clear and well substantiated terms. Many of you will be familiar with some photographs of organisms, living tissues, which disclose a strange, radiant glow around those tissues ("Kirlian photography"). Nobody doubts the existence of this glow, which fades away if the cells and tissues die, but as to the explanation, it had been formulated long before the phenomenon was disclosed by technical methods. This glow is the <u>Lifgeislan</u>, the bioradiation phenomenon predicted and explained in the widest scientific context by Dr. Helgi Pjeturss many decades

ago. All our mental and vital excertions are accompanied by the Lif-geislan, which is the energetic correlative of the chemical and physiological processes, which have been so intensely studied.

In general, the smaller fields of cells, organs etc. compose the organism's entire vital field of force, which indeed links together all the organic processes, lets them work purposefully and is in essence: the individual Will. The opposite belief is a relic from the Middle Ages, from the time when no one knew that there are other stars. You know that Giordano lived and discovered the uncountable worlds. You know that Lamarck lived and discovered the true evolutionism, which reveals that evolution is a trend towards aims, an effortrof an omnipresent Will. This will is present in yourself: tat tvam asi, you are that. When you know this, when you feel this in yourself, you will be able to understand what evolution created on the uncountable worlds. It created something like yourself, something very similar. Of course there are also worlds on a much more primitive stage than ours is now, as well as those far advanced. So you feel it and so it is.

By now you have learnt to think of yourself as a penetrating, upwards striving force, that requires heaven for himself - and at the same time you will recall to have been taught that such thoughts are to be avoided, that they are not good for you. Looking upwards you will ask: where is he who forbids? The endless space, surrounding uncountable worlds, will answer: "Not here, friends, I am only empty space, but ask the stars in my bosom, the abodes of life. There you will find the answer. On the stars you will find my children, your equals, asking the same questions. They are, like you, asking for strength and wisdom, love life and joy. I grant all this to you as soon as you learn to talk together between the stars. Be sure that I am, but I am not he who forbids".

A new breath of air is felt all around, on many planets, and the sister suns shine with a new brilliance. More and more turn their eyes to those who express interstellar opinions. They will not be disappointed. The interstellars will bring to the mankinds what they need. Even in such nests of horrors as our planet still is, recovery and progress will enter and a rejoicing Future stretches her arms towards us.

On April 21rst this year - the last day of the winter, according to the Icelandic calendar, the Danish corvette "Vædderen" sailed into the harbour of Reykjavík with a cargo as unique as important: two old manuscripts which had remained in Denmark over 300 years. It was a gift from the Danish nation to us Icelanders, as a compensation for the misdoings of the past, given back in order to make all good again between these two blood-related nations. May Heaven (innumerable stars) bless this truly Nordic act of the Danish folk, which may, by the example it sets, mark a turning point in the history of mankind.

Virtually it was a force that raged over seventeenth century Europe and manifested itself in intolerance, religious wars and the burning of witches and magicians. It is very important to know the roots of such epidemics, but before going into that we have to remark that the Englich expression "burning of...." sounds too weak and indecisive. It seems as if the English never had the mood and might to create an expression that expels that old shame from the mind. In Icelandic we have the word Galdrabrennur (plur.) which expresses detestation towards that temper of intolerance.

An organisation striving to stimulate them to think about life in the universe has to argue with its own members about the belief that the advanced live in the ammonium and methan of the larger planets - as if there were no other places in the universe. We who are surrounded by uncountable solar systems in all directions. Perhaps, however, this weakness, which, according to UFO-Nyt is prominent in many Ufo-groups, comes from a certain natural need. We need to be able to point out certain definite stars in the stellar neighborhood as the abodes of receivers, to whom we may direct our thoughts. With the help of an advanced science of the mind, such places could be found and explored.

The Two Lines of Evolution

Strangely enough, no philosopher before Helgi Pjeturss discovered the two, most different, lines of evolution: that of the increasing pain, which has prevailed on our earth for the last billion years at least, and that of the increasing well-being and happiness, which prevails on better planets and could be introduced here too. But as soon as centers of Determinants have been established among us, it will be possible to direct energy for relief to the worst spots, and then the mind will be freer for its initiative. Determinants then will be able to concentrate on helping up more promising thought, and we will have the <u>Life line of evolution</u> in sight.
